



Social Networking Policy for Public Use

Protect Yourself-Be Privacy and Security Conscious

Access to the Bank's social networking pages may be terminated if a user uploads, or otherwise makes directly accessible, content which infringes on any other party's copyrights; is considered offensive, off topic, or spam; or is considered to be a personal attack, threatening, derogatory, non-constructive, political or religious in nature. This includes text, links, photos, images, audio, and video. The content will be removed upon discovery and users will be warned. Texas Gulf Bank may terminate repeat offenders' access to Texas Gulf Bank's social networking sites.

No confidential, personal, or banking information, such as account numbers, Debit/ATM/ Credit card numbers, Social Security Number, Passwords or PINs should be shared on social networking sites and will be removed upon discovery by Texas Gulf Bank.
